II. Music and Backgrounds

We want to be very honest and open with you concerning the use of recorded backgrounds. We do use pre-recorded backgrounds about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the time, and piano or a capella the rest. We are a Southern Gospel quartet and we also include traditional Gospel songs and hymns. If you have ever watched any of the Gaither Homecoming materials you will find that we perform similar music. There are backgrounds with some percussion in a Southern style. We do bring along a person who controls the backgrounds and we can safely say that the words of the music are the most

important part, and they are brought out more than the background music itself. Many of our backgrounds are orchestral in nature and done in good taste. We do not wish to offend anyone, especially a pastor and his congregation. We do not over-power the listener and we are very sensitive to the ears of everyone in attendance.
